Opt II is the advanced standing transfer option into the professional M.I.Arch. Program for candidates with a prior pre-professional degrees.

Successful Option II candidates may have curriculum deficiencies that require coursework in addition to the 81 credit hours required to complete the Option II Master of Interior Architecture professional degree program.

Minimum requirements for M.I.Arch. Option II (see M.I.Arch. Option III requirements):

NOTE: Option II students follow many of the professional curriculum requirements of the Option III Program but are admitted with advanced standing. The extent of advance standing is determined in consultation with the student's academic advisor before beginning the course of study. Transferability of prior coursework is provisionable pending satisfactory completion of three terms in residence.
